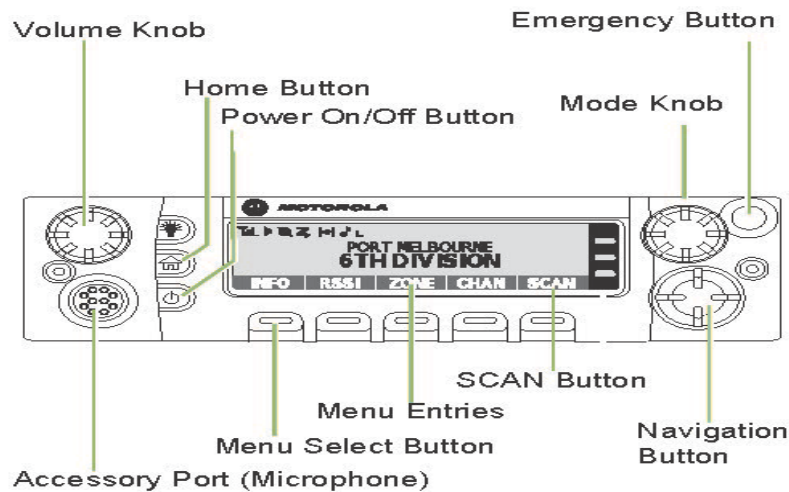


RADIO OPERATION REFERENCE GUIDE



RADIO ON/OFF & VOLUME

- The Power On/Off Button that is located on the module itself.
- Volume knob located on the left of the module.

RECEIVING AND TRANSMITTING

- Select zone/talk group.
 - ALL SCHOOLS – Allows you to talk to 911 center.
- Listen for a transmission.
- Adjust volume, if necessary.
- Press the PTT button to transmit;
 - Wait for indicator to sound
 - Speak clearly and concisely
 - Release when finished

SWITCHING TALK GROUPS

- TURN THE MODE KNOB LOCATED ON THE RIGHT OF THE RADIO MODULE
- Radio will voice what channel you are currently selecting.
 - This knob will allow you to filter through all channels on your radio.

HOME BUTTON

- If at any time you become lost on a channel, you can return to your Primary Talk Group by holding down the home button on the keypad. It is in the upper left corner of the keypad, and has a picture of a home on it.

EMERGENCY BUTTON

- Press the **Emergency** button.
- Press and hold the **PTT** button. Speak clearly into the microphone.
- Release the **PTT** button to end call.
- Press and hold **Emergency** button to exit emergency.

SCAN BUTTON

- You can turn the scan feature on and off at any time by pushing the top most button the side of the radio. (Purple in Color) It is **RECOMMENDED** to turn the scan off once you are assigned an operations channel. This will prevent you from hearing other incidents and causing confusion.
